We work in Burundi, Ethiopia, Kenya, Rwanda, Tanzania and Uganda.



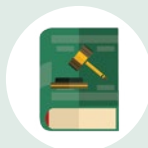

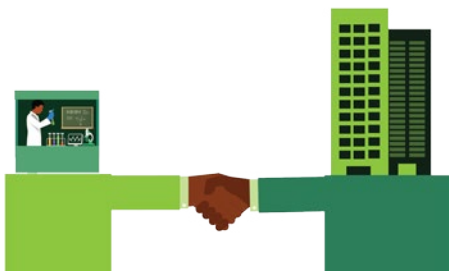

Our mission

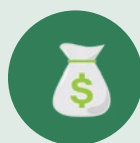
